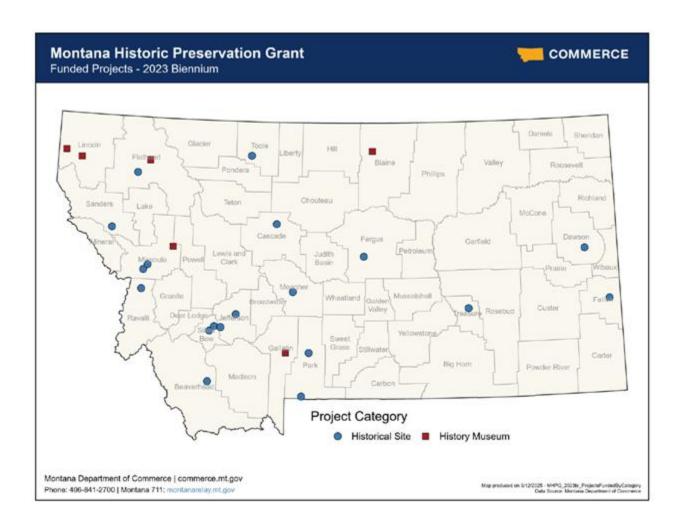


Montana Historic Preservation Grant Program

2023 Biennium Awarded Projects

The Montana Historic Preservation Grant Program is a state-funded program created in 2019 as a result of Senate Bill 338, Sections 1-17. The MHPG Program is designed to support public or private entities with the preservation of historic sites, historical societies or history museums through grant funding.

For the 2023 Biennium, a total of \$5,499,350 was awarded to 26 projects across the state.
