This will be the fifth year that the Montana Department of Commerce has hosted a Montana Pavilion at IWA; we know it's the best show for introducing and promoting Montana products in the European market.

We invite you to participate in the Montana Pavilion at IWA OutdoorClassics, Nuremberg, Germany, Feb. 27-March 2, 2025. Up to eight Montana companies will be part of the Montana Pavilion at IWA and receive a \$2,000 reimbursement for travel expenses. The reimbursement will come from Commerce's State Trade Expansion Program grant, funded by the Small Business Administration.

This will be the easiest and most cost-effective trade show you ever experience. We pay for and organize the booth, furniture, graphics, etc. We also provide information on international travel, what to pack and pre-show marketing, so you'll be well prepared for the show. Additionally, team members from Commerce will be on site to assist with anything you need.

The 18-month sales increase for previous IWA Montana Pavilion participants averages \$116,000. Keeping in mind your total out-of-pocket expense is \$1,500, what a fantastic return on investment!



WHAT WE DO

HOW IT HELPS YOU


- This will be the easiest and most costeffective trade show in which you will ever participate.

Steps for Participating in the Montana Pavilion at IWA

PREPARATION

September-December: Contact Commerce with any questions about the show, the pavilion or the European outdoor market.

APPLICATION

September-December: Fill out the STEP grant application. It should take you 15 minutes or less. We only have eight spots in the booth, so we encourage you to apply ASAP. Contact Commerce for assistance. We will send you confirmation of receipt and acceptance.

ORIENTATION

November: We will host a recorded webinar to prepare you for all aspects of the show, including travel planning, what to pack, how to prepare for the show and how to execute follow-up.

EXHIBIT

February-March: This is a four-day show, running from Feb. 27-March 2, 2025. See the itinerary for details.

REIMBURSEMENT

March: After the show, you can fill out and submit the reimbursement request for your airfare and hotel expenses up to \$2,000. It should take you 15 minutes or less.





WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Any Montana company selling products or services in these or related sectors can participate:

- Hunting
- Camping
- Outdoor recreation
- Knives

- Hiking
- Archery
 - Shooting sports
- Defense

WHAT IS THE COST?

Commerce covers all the costs of the booth, so the only expense to you will be your travel costs in excess of the travel stipend reimbursement.

Total travel costs (approx.) \$3,500 + STEP reimbursement (\$2,000) = Net cost \$1,500

WHAT RESULTS ARE EXPECTED?

\$116,000 in new exports*
a return on investment of 77:1**
