




Made in Montana Trade Show Booth Examples

All flooring and product must fit inside your booth footprint, no exceptions.

Booth spaces designed for open viewing - please do not block your neighbor. Solid side panels or grids with product cannot extend beyond six feet from the back wall of the booth. Only moveable, non-solid displays may be used on the final 4' of display space towards the aisle.

Pop up canopies are not allowed however, you may use the frame alone for lighting or hanging items for sale.



"Stair Step" Pipe & Drape Booth Structure Information:


- Pipe & Drape Color: Solid Black
- Booth Footprint: Booths 101 708 are 10' wide x 10' deep
- Booths 709, 801-813 are 10' wide x 8' deep
- Back wall: 8' high
- Side divider: 8' high extending 6' from back wall, and then 3' high to aisle for 4'

Each booth includes:


- One 6' x 24" skirted table (30" high; black skirt; white top)
- One 500 watt/110v electrical outlet per booth (exhibitor must supply own extension cord)
- 2 chairs (standard height self-service when you arrive at show)
- Double booths include 4 chairs, two tables, two electrical sources.







10' by 10' Inline Booth




10' by 10' Corner Booth








Example of neighboring inline booths, set-up for Wholesale Buyer Day. Note the open view between booths and use of low, movable counters and displays in the front of the booth.




20' x 10' Double Inline Booth
