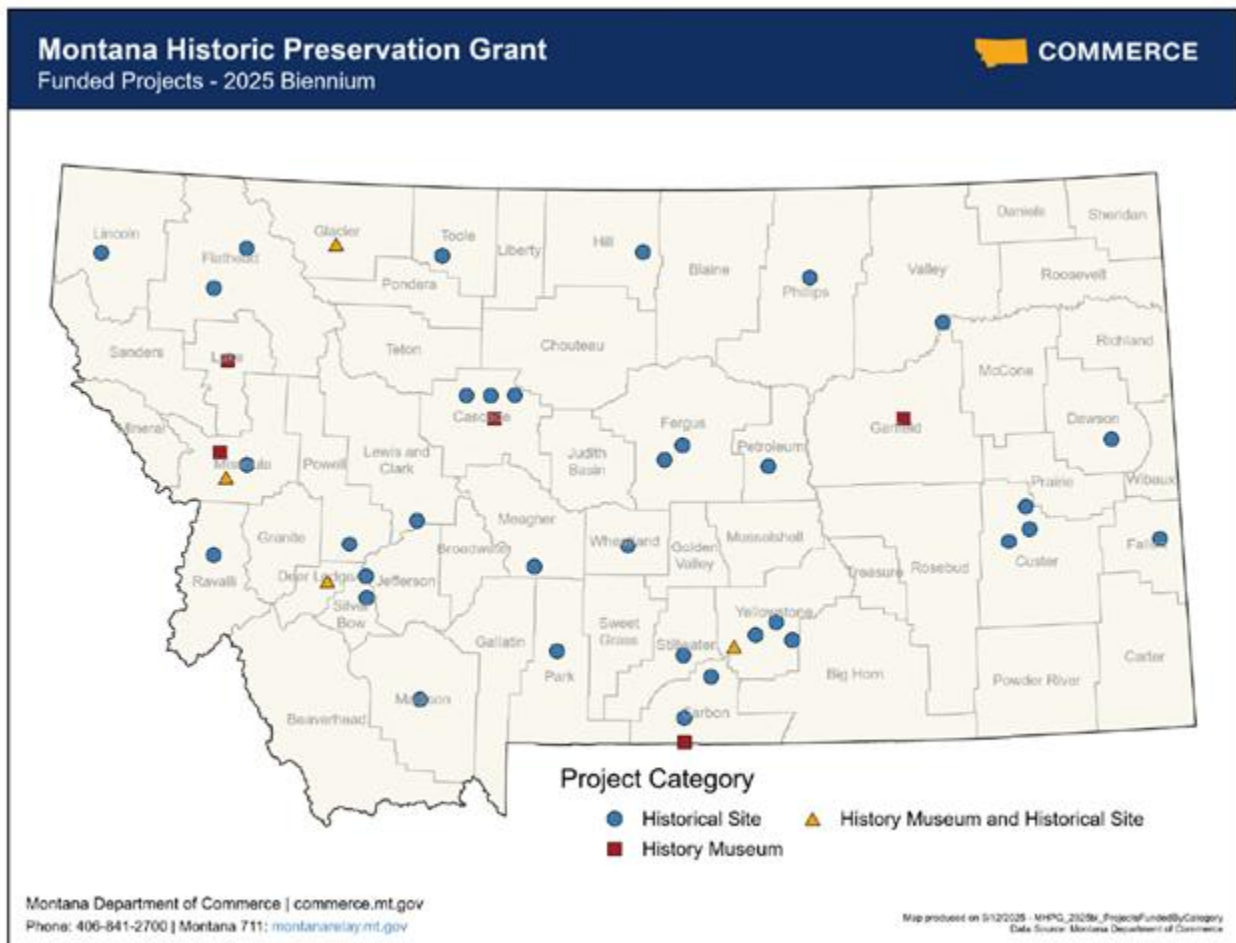


Montana Historic Preservation Grant Program

2025 Biennium Awarded Projects

The Montana Historic Preservation Grant Program is a state-funded program created in 2019 as a result of Senate Bill 338, Sections 1-17. The MHPG Program is designed to support public or private entities with the preservation of historic sites, historical societies or history museums through grant funding.

For the 2025 Biennium, a total of \$11,182,044 was awarded to 39 projects across the state.

*Garfield County declined its award for the Garfield County Museum; Montana Heritage Commission returned its award for the Hickman House; Friends of the Historical

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Museum at Fort Missoula returned its award for the Historical Museum at Fort Missoula; and Community Health Care Center, Inc., dba Alluvion Health's contract was terminated. The declined, returned and terminated awards returned reduced the total awarded by \$1,141,273.

**Original Montana Club Cooperative Association sold the Original Montana Club, and the new owners requested approval from the Legislature to reassign the 2025 Biennium award to Rathskeller, LLC. That request was approved.
