2024 was a slow year in the bond market as high interest rates and the lingering impact of inflation kept demand for new debt low. Despite being a slow year for bonds, the MFFA still had a busy 2024 with fifteen financings completed totaling over \$9.7 million. This includes our busiest calendar year for C-PACE to date, with four closings totaling over \$2.3 million with projects in Butte, Bozeman and Billings.

MILESTONES & ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2024 INCLUDED:

- Issuing over \$3.1 million in Direct Loans (eight loans) and \$4.3 million in Trust Fund Loans (three loans) and structuring over \$2.3 million in C-PACE financings (four projects) raising our total financings structured since 1983 to over \$4.13 billion.
- Expanding C-PACE reach into new locations including Ravalli,
 Jefferson, Musselshell, and Powell Counties, and the city of Whitefish.

- Closing on a C-PACE financing for the Hedden Empire Building in downtown Billings. The \$1.6 million financing will allow for significant energy efficiency improvements in the 95-year-old building. The C-PACE improvements will open up unused portions of the building to further development and are estimated to generate up to \$13 million in savings and additional revenue.
- Closing on a Direct Loan for Clark Fork Valley Hospital. The \$211,749 loan was used to purchase replacement endoscopy equipment allowing the hospital to continue offering this service.

We look forward to the challenges and expectations of the future and want to thank our dedicated and forward-looking Board of Directors, our professional staff, financing partners, financial institutions, and associates for your support and expertise.


